You can conduct searches using abbreviations for index terms in the search box. This is an additional way to combine searches right in the search box. For example, inputting

“au: shakespeare ti: hamlet yr: 1980 ln: fre”

searches for copies of Shakespeare’s Hamlet published in 1980 in the French language. Searching for

“kw: genetic engineering dt:art yr: 1995..2000”

searches for the keywords genetic engineering in document type articles in the years 1995-2000.
