



I have read and agree to the terms of the SAE DIGITAL CONTENT LICENSE AGREEMENT dated 10/04/2013 between SAE International and The California Digital Library, University of California Office of the President having its principal place of business at 415 20th Street, 4th Floor Oakland, CA 94612 USA. The undersigned parties, for good consideration, do hereby agree to make the following changes and/or additions that are outlined below. These additions shall be made valid as if they are included in the original stated contract.

Amend Clause 1 of the Original License Agreement to include the SAE Technical Paper Archive 1906-1997 and add the following terms that relate to perpetual access of this content only to be accessed by 4 campuses UC Berkeley, UCLA, UC Irvine, and UC Davis

Perpetual Access

Licensor hereby grants to Licensee a perpetual license to use the SAE Technical Paper Backfile (1906-1997) that the Licensee accessed during the duration of the Agreement. Such use shall be in accordance with the provision of this Agreement, which provisions shall survive any termination of this Agreement. The licensee shall have access to the SAE Backfile in a manner and form equivalent or comparable to the means by which access is provided under this Agreement.

Licensor will make reasonable efforts to maintain the backfile of technical papers 1906 to 1997 on the Digital Library. In the event that it proves commercially unreasonable for Licensor to maintain the ongoing availability of the Digital library backfile, Licensor will make a conservation copy of the archive available through a mutually agreeable form
