Integrated Link Resolver and A-Z (WorldCat Local)

New Note fields available for records in A-Z and the Link Resolution pages

Notes fields added in the WorldCat Knowledge Base are now publicly available through the A-Z page and Link Resolution page for both electronic and print holdings. Notes are available for the following fields: collection, title, coverage, and Location. The A-Z and link resolution interface will hyperlink any note URLs automatically without the need for inserting HTML code into the knowledge base.



A-Z Browse for eBooks

Patrons now have the ability to browse eBooks via an A-Z list.

Improvements

- Journal and eBooks Search: added a Boolean AND search option as “Match all words”.
- Journal and eBooks Search: Enabled “Starts with” as the default search type.
- Link Resolution page now performs a “Starts with” search for inbound OpenURL requests.
- Removed the A-Z browse feature from the “Articles” tab on the A-Z list. A-Z browsing is now available from the Journals and eBooks tabs.
- Added additional A-Z browse links: “0-9” for titles beginning with numerals and “Other” for titles beginning with a non-Roman character.
- Included Reference Manager as a citation download option.

- Improved Print labeling in the A-Z: When a print collection is presented to a patron via browsing the A-Z, the label will display “Available in” followed by the collection name. Electronic collections continue to display “Full text from” followed by the collection name.
- Link Resolution page no longer suggests the first ISSN/eISSN found for any search. This improves the user experience for partial or incorrect citation searches.
- Link Resolution page print holdings no longer present a non-hyperlinked URL leading to the collection. The “More Information” link still takes the patron to the collection.
- Improved flexibility for the base URL of the Link Resolver. Legacy OpenURL commands will be processed correctly.

Bug Fixes

- Journal and eBooks Search: “Match any words” now correctly performs a Boolean OR search
- Embargo periods now rendering correctly. For example, an embargo period will display “1885~up to 1 year ago” instead of a code representing the embargo.
- Secure access to both the A-Z and Link Resolver, via https, no longer displays a warning from the browser indicating some of the content is unsecure.
